On 8/24/20 at 1609 hours, Deputy Collins was dispatched to ██████████ Orange City, FL, in reference to a suicidal person.

Upon arrival Deputy Collins made contact with ██████████ (RI) who advised she received a call from ██████████ (VI) indicating he wanted to shoot himself in the head.

Deputy Collins made contact with ██████████ who stated he was feeling stressed out by life, and he didn't know what to do. ██████████ advised he had considered killing himself today. ██████████ also advised he had access to one shotgun inside his home.

Deputy Collins determined ██████████ could not determine if an examination was necessary. Deputy Collins established there was substantial likelihood without care or treatment ██████████ would cause serious bodily harm to himself in the near future, as evidenced by recent behavior.

Deputy Collins took ██████████ into custody to be Baker Acted and transported him to Stewart-Marchman Act in Daytona Beach for further evaluation and treatment.

Later, Deputy Collins made phone contact with ██████████ who advised she responded to ██████████ (█████████'s residence) where she checked ██████████'s room and closet. ██████████ stated she was unable to locate ██████████'s Remington Model 1100 shotgun. ██████████ said she was told by the other residents that they observed ██████████ remove the shotgun from the home a few days prior.

Deputy Collins completed the necessary RPO paperwork, which was forwarded to the VSO Legal advisor for further processing.
