AFFIDAVIT

I, {full legal name} Tyler King, in my position as {job title} Deputy with the {name of law enforcement officer/agency} Volusia Sheriff's Office, swear and affirm that the following facts are true and correct.

1. {Name of Respondent} ██████████ poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to himself/herself or others by having a firearm or any ammunition in his/her custody or control or by purchasing, possessing or receiving a firearm or any ammunition. The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

On Wednesday, June 16, 2021 at 0817 hours deputies were dispatched to ██████████ ██████████ Deltona in reference to a well being check. Prior to arrival, Central Dispatch advised the reporting party, ██████████ (R1), had called stating the homeowner of the previously mentioned address, ██████████ (O1), was threatening to kill his step son. ██████████ further explained he believed ██████████ was bipolar and off of his

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medications.

Upon arrival, Deputy King began approaching the home's front door. As Deputy King neared the door, he passed in front of a set of windows at the front of the home. As Deputy King walked past the windows, he observed ██████ quickly jump in front of the window from the couch. ██████ then screamed, "Do not come any closer! I mean it; stay the fuck away! I'll put the next one in my head!" Deputies stepped away from the front of the home, positioned themselves behind cover, and notified Central Dispatch of ██████ statement via radio.

Numerous other VSO Deputies responded to the scene and created a perimeter around the residence while Deputy Hachenberger made contact with ██████ via telephone. ██████ explained he was enraged with his step-son, Albert Warman (O2), because he had failed to return his electric bicycle. ██████ yelled for nearly the entire duration of the two hour phone conversation with Deputy Hachenberger. During the conversation, ██████ repeatedly threatened to shoot himself and anyone who neared the front of his residence or yard. At this time, a neighbor was walking her dog in front of ██████ house when he stated, the next person to walk in front of my house is getting shot. ██████ also repeatedly threatened to kill ██████ After speaking on and off with Deputy Hachenberger for approximately two hours, the VSO Hostage Negotiation Team arrived on scene at which time Sergeant Turney began speaking with ██████ ██████ continued to yell and threaten himself and ██████ During the conversation with Sergeant Turney, ██████ also threatened to respond to his previous place of employment, Gittmer Architectural Aluminum in Winter Springs, and shoot the employees on scene. Shortly thereafter, ██████ began sounding more lethargic and stopped responding to Sergeant Turney.

Deputy Hachenberger positioned his VSO patrol vehicle near the front of ██████ residence and made numerous PA announcements asking for ██████ to return to his phone; however, the announcements received no response.

During the investigation, contact was made with several neighbor's and ██████ who confirmed ██████ lives alone and was in possession of several firearms approximately one week earlier. They each advised ██████ potentially had a rifle, shotgun, and several handguns within the residence.

Stewart Marchman ACT staff members also made several attempts to contact ██████ via telephone. They advised ██████ briefly answered his phone and stated "I can't talk right now; I'm busy".

After numerous failed attempts to regain contact with ██████ via telephone, deputies left the area to avoid escalating the situation.

Based upon ██████ numerous threats towards himself and others with firearms he is believed to be in possession of, Deputy King completed a Risk Protection Order.


